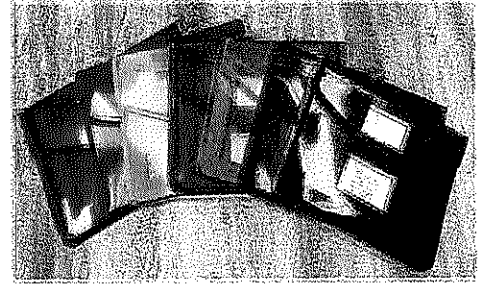




Checklist for Hospital Folder

As a follow-up to our Social Services Update presentation on emergency planning, we are providing the requested checklist as a guide to help residents remember what to include in their bright hospital folder (as pictured), for quick access to documents needed in the event of a planned or unplanned hospitalization. Please feel free to request one from your IL Social Worker and remember to place your folder in a place where it can be easily located and retrieved.

Please include a Copy of your:

- **Health Insurance Cards (front and back)**
- **MOLST (Maryland Order of Life Sustaining Treatment) form**
- **Advance Directives/ Living Will**
- **Medication List**
- **Copy of CAP form (Communication Access Plan form) for the hearing and visually impaired.**
- **Any health information that you want a first responder to know in the event of a health emergency (i.e. drug Allergies, pacemaker, shunt, etc.)**
- **The Hospital and Primary Care Information wallet cards are already included in your folder.**
